By attending workshops on social safety, migration and human rights, the participant gained knowledge, skills and tools to take local action. They also developed and implemented a project, and shared their results with policy makers, educators and human rights professionals.

Description of activities

Something creative

As part of the Move 4 Human Rights Summer Edition, apart from the fixed programme which includes workshops and sessions with experts from the human rights field, participants are asked to develop, organize and implement their own collaborative projects. Those who chose the Justice & Peace trajectory, were asked to contribute to a more welcoming society for newcomers. Victor Johnson and the group chose to celebrate and highlight the people and communities that shape The Hague's cultural landscape. By visually telling the stories of different businesses with diverse cultural markers, they highlighted the richness migration brings to the city. In this way, the group creatively and physically gave space to an alternative narrative on migration.

Through interactive workshops, field visits, and collaborative projects, the Move 4 Human Rights Summer Edition provides a space for its participants in which human rights theory meets practice. Participants have not only learned more about pressing human rights issues (inter)nationally, they have also contributed to impactful solutions. After completing the programme they have deepened their understanding of the field, gained hands-on experience, and contributed to a network of like-minded changemakers.
